APPELLANT'S CLOSING BRIEF

In the file is an affidavit by Ms. Alena Appia that defendant Legal Services Plan Of America couldn't or wouldn't furnish her an attorney for her trial in Van Nuys, California, and she had to retain an attorney not affiliated with the plan, Henry Himmlefarb.

This supports plaintiff/appellant's contention that attorneys who sign-up with such plans won't work for free or at a reduced fee, and only use their affiliation to obtain cases that will earn a contingency fee with little effort.

Summary judgment is precluded until plaintiff/appellant can pursue discovery to verify his contention.

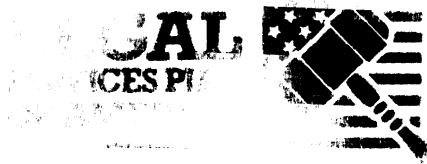
