Foreword: The 1988 Omnibus Trade Bill—Issues and Perspectives

This issue marks the fourth edition of the J. Reuben Clark International and Comparative Law Annual. The annual is the composite work of the BYU International and Comparative Law Society (ICLS) and the Law Review.

The articles published in this issue are based on a conference held at BYU's J. Reuben Clark Law School on January 13-14, 1989, dealing with the 1988 Omnibus Trade Bill. Many of the articles included are transcripts of presentations made at the conference, and as such, are not in normal Law Review format. Nevertheless, the articles represent a broad range of views on the Trade Bill, including views from the Administration, Congress, the private sector, the Japanese government, and the European Community.

In addition to the transcripts of presentations made at the conference, the Law Review invited comments from students enrolled in classes studying international trade and the 1988 Trade Bill. These comments are also included in this edition.
