STATEMENT OF AUTHORITIES

1. Basis of exclusive jurisdiction in the United States: Article 1, Section 8, Clause 17, United States Constitution.

2. For the proposition that jurisdiction is acquired by cession: Kohl v. United States, 91 U.S. 367, 23 L. Ed. 449.

3. For the proposition that the United States may acquire jurisdiction by means of condemnation: United States v. Jones, 109 U.S. 513, 27 L. Ed. 1015.

4. For the proposition that the United States acquires jurisdiction by using owned property for purposes of the government (those described in Article I, Section 8, Clause 17): Fort Leavenworth Railroad v. Lowe, 114 U.S. 525, 531, 29 L. Ed. 264, 266.
