Dear Ms. Branch:

Pursuant to rule 24(i), Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure, I am citing the Utah Supreme Court's recent decision in State v. Dennis Shoulderblade, No. 930518 (Utah October 23, 1995), and this Court's recent decision in State v. Brent Zieglerman, No. 940448-CA (Utah App. October 26, 1995) as supplemental authority to Point III of the State's brief in State v. Ham, case no. 950062-CA. The State is citing Zieglerman as this Court's most recent case on attenuation analysis; however, it was issued almost simultaneously with Shoulderblade and consequently does not cite Shoulderblade. Oral argument in this case is scheduled for November 15, 1995.
